Coca-Cola Enterprises, Inc. is one of the world's largest producers, marketers and distributors of Coca-Cola products. Sue assumed her current position in May 2009, bringing more than 20 years of financial and audit leadership in both public and private accounting.

She began her career at Deloitte & Touche LLP in Boston. During her time there, she focused on high technology and manufacturing clients and managed initial and subsequent public stock offerings. After seven years in Boston, she was selected for a two-year Management Development Program at the firm's headquarters in Wilton, Connecticut, where she managed the practice review program. She then transferred to the firm's San Francisco office where she spent an additional five years providing attest and consulting services to various high technology and not-for-profit clients.

Sue joined Sun Microsystems, Inc. in 1997 as the external reporting manager and subsequently assumed responsibility for the consolidations group as well. After two years in that role, she then held a series of finance roles in support of various engineering and sales groups within the company. In 2003 she was named Assistant Controller, Policies and Practices, where she was responsible for establishing the Sarbanes-Oxley Section 404 compliance program. She was promoted to Vice President, Internal Audit in October of 2004 where she was responsible for conducting financial, operation, compliance, and IT audits, as well as special projects and investigations.

In 2006 Sue joined Coca-Cola Enterprises Inc. as the Vice President, Internal Audit, where she was responsible for leading a 45-person team and for designing and implementing the company's worldwide internal audit program. In her current role she is responsible for financial transaction processing, accounting policies and practices, and the preparation and public filing of the company's financial statements. Sue also played a key role in the 2010 transaction between Coca-Cola Enterprises and The Coca-Cola Company in which the North American business was sold, the Norway and Sweden businesses were acquired, and the company was recapitalized.

Sue is on the Board of Directors and Audit Committee of the Girl Scouts of Greater Atlanta. She is also a mentor in the Pathbuilders Achieva program.

Sue holds a B.A. in Psychology from Colby College in Waterville, Maine, and a Master of Science/M.B.A. from Northeastern University in Boston, Massachusetts. She is both a Certified Public Accountant and a Certified Fraud Examiner.
